Overview

Burtons takes its responsibility seriously in respect of securing the integrity and confidentiality of your personal information shared with us. We will not sell or share the personal information or use in ways different from what is disclosed in this policy.

General Privacy

We may only use your personal details to contact you about matters directly related to our website, social media sites or for the services which we may render to you. Your personal information as provided by you will never be used for marketing purposes outside of our direct services.

Log Files

We use IP addresses to analyse trends, administer the site, track users' movements, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.

Cookies

Cookies are little bits of data a web browser uses to keep track of visitor activity. We use "cookies" to "remember" log-in details of users who enter the website. A "cookie" is a text file that is placed on your hard drive by a web page server. Each time the browser requests a page from the server, this text is sent back. "Cookies" are not used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. "Cookies" are uniquely assigned to your computer and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. Usage of a "cookie" is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information while on our site.

Security and Data Storage

This website takes every precaution to protect our users' information online. We also do everything in our power to protect user and client information offline.
